PRIVATE PILOT LICENSE COURSE





OFFICIAL REGULAITON

The minimum requirements to obtain the Airplane Private Pilot License are the following:

- Minimum Age: 17 years old
- Theoretical Knowledge: In accordance with the syllabus and official manuals
- Flight Instruction: In accordance with the official syllabus
- Experience: A minimum of 45 flight hours, of which 5 can be in a simulator. A minimum of 10 hours of solo flight must be carried out, which will include 5 hours of cross-country and at least one trip of a minimum of 270km during which landings will be made at two different aerodromes
- Psycophysical Fitness: Class II Medical Certificate (to be issued by an authorized centre)

In accordance with official regulations, a Private Pilot privileges are as follows:

Act without compensation or hire as pilot in command or as co-pilot of any aircraft, under visual flight conditions or others duly qualified, in single-engine piston land aircraft or in any other with the required rating.

COURSE DEVELOPMENT

The Real Aero Club de Baleares carries out this course according to the training cycle to obtain the Airplane Private Pilot Title and License with its theoretical and practical parts, lasting a period of approximately FOUR months, depending on the student's availability.

The <u>theory classes</u> are coordinated in advance with the instructor and can be individual or in group, depending on the availability of the student.

The theory will have a minimum duration of 120 hours, not including revisions and internal exams, distributed in the following subjects:

- Principles of Flight
- Communications
- Aircraft General Knowledge
- Performance, mass and balance
- Human Performance and Limitations
- Meteorology
- Air Law
- Operational Procedures
- General Navigation

The flying lessons are coordinated with the instructor and scheduled via our internal system.

During the Private Pilot Course of the Real Aeroclub de Baleares, FORTY-FIVE hours of flight are carried out in a Cessna C-172N.

Any excess to this flight time (normally sufficient to obtain the corresponding title) will be borne by the student pilot.

The duration of the flight exam is usually variable (between one and two hours of flight), this cost will be borne by the student (not included in the price of the course).
